

## **Justice Ssemogerere Donates Furniture to Christ the King Parish as a Thanksgiving Offering**

The Resident Judge of the Kabale High Court Circuit, Justice Ssemogerere Karoli Lwanga, made a generous donation of three high-quality furniture pieces to Christ the King Parish in Kabale Municipality this morning. The donation, intended for use by priests during Mass, was made as a personal thanksgiving gesture to God.
