

Kabale High Court Hosts RCC Meeting on Child Justice.

Kabale High Court yesterday convened a Regional Coordination Committee (RCC) meeting presided over by the Resident Judge, Justice Ssemogerere Karoli Lwanga.

The meeting brought together the Assistant Registrar and stakeholders under the Justice, Law and



Order Sector (JLOS) to deliberate on strengthening Child Justice in the region.

Discussions centered on the prompt handling of child-related cases, fast-tracking trials, enhancing child-friendly holding facilities, and supporting probation and social welfare officers to effectively discharge their mandate.

In his remarks, Justice Lwanga revealed that the Ministry of Gender, Labour and Social Development had

released UGX 1,552,861,254 to probation offices through the Chief Administrative Officers (CAOs). He tasked the CAOs to ensure that these funds are made accessible to probation and social welfare officers for their work.

The Judge also highlighted progress within the region, including the posting of a State Prosecutor to Rubanda, securing of premises for the establishment of a Magistrate Grade One Court in Rukiga, approval for the Kisoro Municipal Council Court, and the planned establishment of a Court at Rububure.

The stakeholders reaffirmed their commitment to strengthening teamwork, coordination, and cross-sectoral collaboration to improve justice delivery in the region.
